- I. Call to Order: Mayor Ken Padilla called the meeting to order at 6:34 P.M. Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.
- II. Consent Agenda: Sharon Monroe made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, Amanda Molnar seconded, passed unanimously, 5 -0.
- III. Adoption of Resolution for 2025 – 2026 Budget: Sharon Monroe made a motion to approve the 2025-2026 Budget, Bob Sutherland seconded, passed unanimously, 5 -0.
- IV. City Secretary Part-Time Position: Sharon Monroe made a motion, Amanda Molnar seconded, passed unanimously, 5 -0.
- V. Personnel Policy: Discussion was opened on Personnel Policy. A copy will be emailed to all Council Members for review. No action was taken.
- VI. Mayor Choice Award for Christmas Parade: Sharon Monroe made a motion to approve \$100 Mayor Choice Award for the Christmas Parade, Amanda Molnar seconded, passed unanimously, 5 -0.
- VII. Wastewater Treatment Plant Cameras: Removed. Not tabled.
- VIII. CPR/1st Aid Training by Campbell Volunteer Fire Department: Discussion was determined that training would cost \$25 per person to be certified with CPR and 1st Aid. Sharon Monroe made a motion, Amanda Molnar seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- IX. Community Service Program: Sharon Monroe made a motion to restart the Community Service Program with Hunt County Probation Office, Amanda Molnar seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- X. Economic Development Corporation Funding Volunteer Fire Department with Lifepak 15 Patient Monitor: Sharon Monroe made a motion to approve Campbell EDC funding the Volunteer Fire Department with up to \$15,000 of funds for refurbished Lifepak 15 Patient Monitor, Bob Sutherland seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- XI. City Contract with Campbell Volunteer Fire Department: The City will sign a contract to fund the volunteer fire department with \$5,000 for the attachments for the Lifepak 15 Patient Monitor. The attachments will include battery, charging cord, leads, access and other required cords and connections. Sharon Monroe made a motion, Bob Sutherland seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- XII. Unifirst Contract Cancellation: Sharon Monroe made a motion to cancel the contract with purchase of the uniforms for \$737, Bob Sutherland seconded, passed unanimously, 5 -0.
- XIII. Contract with SPI for Renewal of Wastewater Treatment Plant permit: SPI completed our previous permit renewal. Sharon Monroe made a motion to approve the contract with SPI, Amanda Molnar seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- XIV. Estimate for Wastewater Treatment Plant: A R2 10'1/4 turn valves at sewer plant and patch bleach injection pipe estimate was presented to City Council. Bob Sutherland made

a motion to consider the estimate to make repairs at Wastewater Treatment Center. Sharon Monroe seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0. **Page 3**

- XV. City Wide Clean Up: Discussion was opened about possible dates for this year. It was stated that participants will have to show proof that they reside in Campbell. It was decided that either Sewer or Water bill would be sufficient as proof. Amanda Molnar made a motion to have Mayor and Dylan pick a date before Thanksgiving and another one at the end of the year. Bob Sutherland seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- XVI. TML Ballot for District Director: Mayor informed Council that Wes Mays personally reached out to City to inform of his experience. Sharon Monroe made a motion for the City of Campbell to cast our vote for Wes Mays, Amanda Molnar seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- XVII. Public Input Time Frame: Discussion was opened. Sharon Monroe made a motion to have the Public Input before items are discussed and to leave the limit of 3 minutes per individual. Sharon Monroe made a motion, Bob Sutherland seconded, passed unanimously, 5-0.
- XVIII. Presentation by Citizens: Kandy Willaby made a comment that the estimate was provided by plumber that no longer held a license. Brief discussion determined that the work that needed to be done did not require a licensed plumber.

- XX. Adjournment: Mayor Ken Padilla adjourn the Council Meeting at 7:36 PM.
